ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. The City Council finds that the areas described in Sections 2 through 12 of this ordinance are adversely affected by the over-concentration of businesses licensed to sell alcoholic liquor within and near the areas.

SECTION 2. Section 4-60-022 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by replacing subsection 4-60-022 (24.206), which was previously deleted as shown in the Journal of Proceedings of January 13, 2009 at page 52730, with the following underscored text:

4-60-022 (24.206) On Cullerton Street. From Keeler Avenue to Kostner Avenue.

SECTION 3. Section 4-60-022 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by replacing subsection 4-60-022 (24.211), with the following underscored text:

4-60-022 (24.211) On the north side of Cermak Road, from Kilbourn Avenue to Kildare Avenue.

SECTION 4. Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by replacing subsection 4-60-023 (24.32), with the following underscored text:

4-60-023 (24.32) On Roosevelt Road, from Albany Avenue to Homan Avenue.

SECTION 5. Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by replacing subsection 4-60-023 (24.33), which was previously deleted as shown in the Journal of Proceedings of December 12, 2018 at page 92503, with the following underscored text:

4-60-023 (24.33) On Roosevelt Road, from Homan Avenue to Central Park Avenue.

SECTION 6. Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by replacing subsection 4-60-023 (24.35), with the following underscored text:

4-60-023 (24.35) On Roosevelt Road, from Independence Boulevard to Pulaski Road.

SECTION 7. Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by replacing subsection 4-60-023 (24.36), which was previously deleted as shown in the Journal of Proceedings of January 13, 2018 at page 17110, with the following underscored text:

4-60-023 (24.36) On Roosevelt Road, from Pulaski Road to Keeler Avenue.

SECTION 8. Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by replacing subsection 4-60-023 (24.78), with the following underscored text:

4-60-023 (24.78) North side of Cermak Road, Marshall Boulevard to Kedzie Avenue.

SECTION 9. Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by replacing subsection 4-60-023 (24.85), which was previously deleted as shown in the Journal of Proceedings of February 10, 2016 at page 18530, with the following underscored text:

4-60-023 (24.85) On Ogden Avenue, from Homan Avenue to Central Park Avenue.

SECTION 10. Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by replacing subsection 4-60-023 (24.214), with the following underscored text:

4-60-023 (24.214) On Kostner Avenue, from Van Buren Street to Fifth Avenue.


SECTION 11. Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by replacing subsection 4-60-023 (24.216), which was previously deleted as shown in the Journal of Proceedings of July 28, 2011 at page 5057, with the following underscored text:

4-60-023 (24.216) On Pulaski Road from 19th Street to Cermak Road.

SECTION 12. Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by replacing subsection 4-60-023 (24.227), which was previously deleted as shown in the Journal of Proceedings of March 18, 2015 at page 103955, with the following underscored text:

4-60-023 (24.227) On Cicero Avenue from Jackson Boulevard to Congress Parkway.

SECTION 13. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
