Openlands suggests the following comments:

3.9.10. Disposal Facilities The Operating Plan shall identify all disposal facilities to which Liquid Waste and residual Waste from the Facility will be hauled. The information shall include: 3.9.10.1.1. The name and location of all disposal and other facilities where Waste, uncontaminated soil, and incidental debris will be disposed of or recycled.

- It is very important to understand the end user in the materials to be repurposed. It would be helpful to know who those entities currently are, where they are located, how often they remove the materials from the storage sites, and their current mode of transporting those materials.
- It would be helpful to the end user to have us understand what products are created from the repurposed materials and if those are used locally or outside the City/region.
- If the entities would be able to remove the materials in a safe way and more often, there would be less issue with storage on site.
- Our last recommendation would be to have consistent funding for City inspectors.
