Notice of 10-Day Extension of Comment Period for Variance Application from KCBX

For a Variance from the City of Chicago Rules and Regulations Pertaining to the Handling and Storage of Bulk Material Piles

Pursuant to Section 8.0(5) of the City of Chicago Department of Public Health (CDPH) Rules and Regulations for Control of Emissions from the Handling and Storage of Bulk Material Piles, notice is hereby given this 13th day of January 2015 that, upon request from members of the public, CDPH is hereby extending the public comment period by ten days from the previous due date with respect to a variance application submitted to CDPH on behalf of KCBX Terminals Company, concerning the properties at 3259 East 100th Street and 10730 South Burley Avenue, Chicago, Illinois.
