Sewer Televising Program services - Area 1, South

The Department of Water Management(DOWM) is requesting an emergency contract in the amount of \$250,000.00 for Sewer Televising Program Services – Area 1, South. This contract is used for the cleaning and televising of sewer mains and lateral drains in the South District(This District is the area of the City bounded by West 51st Street on the North and the City Limits on the East, West and South)of the City. The video recordings resulting from the televising are used by our investigation section to determine the condition of potential failing sewer and lateral structures. This serves as a important preventative measure to assure the structural integrity of the City's Sewer System. The City can decide if a certain section of sewer main needs immediate repairs or can just be routed through the normal construction schedule. Therefore, since operations have ceased, this increases the possibility of a sewer collapse without notice, which could make the City liable for resulting flooded basements.

DOWM requested a time extension, however the Vendor(National Power Rodding, Inc.) refused to extend the contract(P.O. No. 10853) which expired on 1/31/2012. This Department is currently working with Department of Procurement Services(DPS) to create a new contract(Requisition No. 67340). The emergeny contract limit(\$250,000.00) will be sufficient enough(2 to 3 Months) to continue operations until the proposed new agreement is in place .If DPS approves this request, DOWM shall solicit quotes from the following vendors:
