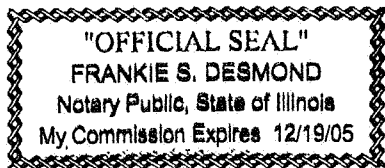

This Department is requesting the Contractor to complete the following workscope:

- Excavate and expose, existing Fiber(M.C.I.) duct, and sewer trench area to appropriate depth.Repeat this procedure at another location on W. 37th Street and S. State Street.
- Hang Duct in two(2) directions by attaching to a I-beam. Repeat this procedure at another location on W. 37th Street and S. State Street.
- After sewer crew installs new sewer pipe at both subject locations, proceed to remove steel beams and straps and encase duct in new concrete concrete under the supervision and direction of M.C.I..
- Backfill to grade with sand at both subject locations.


Further street restoration shall be performed by the sewer construction crew. This work shall be performed in accordance with all applicable codes and guidelines.

Estimated duration of this Project is **twenty(20) calendar days**.




