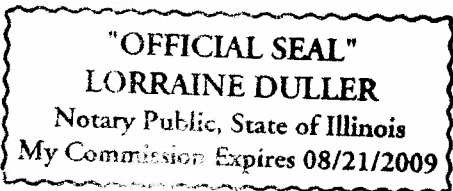

Enclosed is the preliminary estimate of cost for the work involved and a project description. Funding for this work is in place.

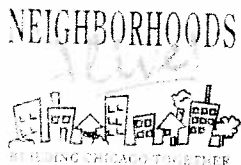
